Instructions: All staff responsible for checking temperatures **must be trained** to properly read the thermometer in each area (Room/Refrigerator). In each of the corresponding columns across the page, the staff person checking the temperature is to record the time, initial, record the temperature, determine if temperature is within range, and document yes it is in range or no it is not in range in the appropriate column. The Head of Clinical Services is to review the temperature log on a weekly basis to determine that proper protocols/documentation was followed and sign-off in the column of the corresponding day the review was completed.
